

F V R October 20, 1927

Mr. & Mrs. J. Martin of Steelhead lose house and contents in fire. There was no insurance. Mrs. Martin confined to hospital with nervous collapse.

F V R March 15, 1928

Steelhead is to have a community hall, made possible by the generosity of P. Hammer who donated a site. An early start will be made on the building and it is hoped to be completed by next June.

F V R January 6, 1933

Steelhead teacher reports school fire extinguisher stolen on the night of the community dance.. At a former dance 14 stovepipes were stolen.

F V R July 13, 1933

Archbishop E. DePencier of the Diocese of Now Wesrminster deicates new Anglican church at Steelhead.

F V R August 31, 1933

Fire at Bain-Johnson's sawmill at Steelhead destorys two miles of plank road, a logging donkey engine and several logger's ~~shaks~~ shacks.

F V R October 29, 1936

Yonzo Magahisa of Steelhead killed in car accident during a dense fog on Lougheed Highway.

F V R June 25, 1946

Grace Holms, Steelhead school teacher wins crown of Strawberry Queen of 1946.

F V R July 7, 1954

St. Paul's church at Steelhead celebrates 21 st annerversary.

F V R March 28 1956

Steelhead residents planning grand opening of new recreation hall.

F V R November 16, 1960

First Steelhead snowfall reported this week.

F V R August 30, 1961

Municipal council give approval for a welfare institution in the Steelhead area off Dewdney Trunk road to be operated by Grant Hoyer. It will serve as a rehabiltation center for former mental hospital patient

F V R July 15, 1964

Three Surrey youths were found shot to death near Steelhead. All Three were found in their sleeping bags at a capsite at the end of Gardina road, seven miles north of Mission City.
